Alex is a member of CornerstoneSF and lives in San Francisco with her husband, Michael, and their three sons. She serves on the Board of Directors for Sunset Youth services and volunteers as a Community Bible Study leader. Alex was born legally blind and has lost her sight gradually due to a retinal disease. She has been living with Stage IV cancer since 2015.

³⁰Leaving that region, they traveled through Galilee.

Jesus didn't want anyone to know He was there,

³¹for He wanted to spend more time with His disciples and teach them. He said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of His enemies. He will be killed, but three days later He will rise from the dead."

³²They didn't understand what He was saying, however, and they were afraid to ask Him what He meant.

³³After they arrived at Capernaum and settled in a house, Jesus asked His disciples, "What were you discussing out on the road?"

³⁴But they didn't answer, because they had been arguing about which of them was the greatest.

³⁵He sat down, called the twelve disciples over to Him, and said, "Whoever wants to be first must take last place and be the servant of everyone else."

³⁶Then He put a little child among them. Taking the child in His arms, He said to them,

³⁷"Anyone who welcomes a little child like this on My behalf welcomes Me, and anyone who welcomes Me welcomes not only Me but also my Father who sent Me."

³Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit.

Rather, in humility value others above yourselves,

⁴not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

⁵In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

⁶Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to His own advantage;

⁷rather, He made Himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

⁸And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

⁹Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name.
